MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY AND BODY SYSTEMS COURSE (MTBS): Science pre-requisite

Course Description: This course is designed to prepare students for the pure science components of the Massage Therapy program. By introducing students to anatomical, physiological and pathological terms, a foundational understanding of the meaning behind the common language used by the health professions will be developed. The purpose of learning and building a medical vocabulary is not only to communicate effectively with other members of the health care team, but also to prepare students for success within the Massage Therapy diploma program.

- ✓ Be knowledgeable about Massage Therapy as a potential profession
- ✓ Be knowledgeable about the history of Swedish massage
- ✓ Understand basic terminology and theoretical concepts of therapeutic massage
- ✓ Be acquainted with, and be able to perform, basic therapeutic massage techniques
- ✓ Gain an awareness of the importance of proper body mechanics
- ✓ Understand the importance of gaining consent and respecting patient boundaries
- Be aware of situations when massage is inappropriate or when it is advisable to refer patients to another professional
